Regular Meetings - February 8, 2021

Bernhardt moved to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of February 8, 2021. Steele, Jr seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

LURA Update

City Manager Steve Adams updated the board on the process for an agreement between the Loveland Urban Renewal Authority and DDA for TIF sharing in the downtown district. City staff has been reviewing financial data and historical information and would be prepared to share this with DDA Executive Director and Council representatives in a session scheduled for the end of the month.

Façade Improvement Agreement – 243 East 4th Street

Hawkins presented a Façade Improvement Agreement for 243 East 4th which is the former Rabask Designs location. The design has been reviewed in multiple meetings with the Façade Review Committee consisting of Jim Cox, Sharon Cook, Clay Caldwell and Doug Rutledge. If approved by the DDA Board, the \$17,552 agreement would then go to the LDP Board for final approval. The project includes new windows, a patio enclosure, brick work and painting and will open the new Sweetheart General Store to considerable more natural light inside the building. There is budget on the LDP side to fund this project.

Steele Jr. moved to approve the Façade Improvement Agreement with Shove Enterprises, LLC and authorize the Board Chair to execute the agreement. Fogle seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Potential Façade Grants

Hawkins briefed the board on two potential façade program inquiries for properties located at 501 N. Cleveland Avenue & 225 S. Cleveland Avenue.

• Potential TIF Investment – Elks Lodge Building

Hawkins introduced Howard Perko who has the Elks Lodge Building on 4th Street under contract and is considering a handful of development options for the property. Perko previously developed the Opera House property on 4th Street and another historic building in Old Town Fort Collins. Howard reviewed new concept that included restoring the original look and entrance along Railroad and the addition of a roof top patio. Perko will visit with the board again as his concept develops.

• Heartland Corner Redevelopment

Jay Hardy and staff from Burgener Holdings introduced a preliminary plan to develop the Heartland Corner and two historic buildings to the east of the corner including a potential new parking garage for the block at 5th and Jefferson. The concept, as it developes, would come back to the DDA in the future for TIF consideration. If warranted, a special session with the DDA would schedule in the next few months.
