Regular Meetings – April 23, 2021

Fogle moved to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of April 23, 2021. Steele Jr. seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

4. Discussion / Action Items

• LURA / DDA -

Scott Schorling from the City of Loveland's Economic Development Department presented the deal points for a TIF sharing agreement between the DDA the Loveland Urban Rewenal Authority. The deal points allow a path for the tax increment generated by the Foundry Project to stay with the project to pay the debt of the Foundry Parking Garage while at the same time allowing the growth in the non-foundry tax increment to be deposited in DDA Fund 650. The board was in consensus to request the City to begin working on the full agreement for DDA Board consideration before routing to the Loveland City Council.

• Foundry Plaza

Hawkins presented some challenges staff was experiencing with maintenance at the Foundry Plaza especially as it relates to the lawn for use on the events. Steve Adams proposed finding a funding solution to fill the 60K gap in budget needed to replace the grass area with stamped concrete. Fogle reminded everyone that no one from the DDA or LDP has a seat on the Metro District board, but clearly a vested interest that a representative attend each board meeting. A meeting between all parties was hoped to be scheduled in the near future to talk through issues. • Fire Suppression Grant

Hawkins presented the fourth project that has applied for Fire Suppression Grant funds. The project is for property that houses the East End Ale House at 418 East 4th Street. The next \$100,000 for the grant program was set to be finalized at the May 17th Loveland City Council meeting. This project is very attractive to the DDA. Not only does it provide life safety upgrades to the building but because of those upgrades, the East End Ale House can now expand into a vacant retail location in the building to add more options to their business. A win win for downtown.

Fogle moved to approve a \$25,000 Fire Suppression Grant with 418-422 East 4th Street LLC and authorize the Executive Director to complete the grant agreement and sign on behalf on the DDA. The grant award is contingent on the City Council's approval of \$100,000 for the 2021 program. The motion was seconded by Steele, Jr and passed unanimously.

• DDA Special Projects

Hawkins reported that the 3rd / Lincoln / Cleveland crossing study and DaVinci Alley study would be able to begin shortly after the dollars are approved in the Cleveland Station Financing Project.
